Unpaid Latinx Services Internship (15-18 hrs/wk): This position will be supervised by the Director of Latinx Services. In addition to your online application, please include an updated resume and cover letter in an email to: (latinx@compassctr.org). Start and end dates are flexible. Application due by January 31st.

In-Office Responsibilities (13-15 hrs/week):

- Assist with daytime domestic violence crisis services in Spanish.
- Assist Spanish-speaking clients filling out domestic violence protection orders.
- Provide support to Spanish-speaking clients with Housing and Mental Health grant applications and process.
- Meet Spanish-speaking clients at court to provide support with domestic violence protection order filing.
- Help keep agency Spanish materials culturally and linguistically relevant.
- Maintain proper documentation of client records.
- Other tasks as assigned by supervisor.

Outreach (3 hrs/week):

- Develop and maintain strong professional relationships with Orange County service providers who work with victims with limited English proficiency.
- Help coordinate community response efforts for victims of domestic violence with limited English proficiency.

Intern Requirements:

- Native Spanish speaker or Spanish fluency required.
- Must have a degree or be working towards a degree in human services/social justice related field (i.e. political science, women's studies, pre-law, psychology, social work, etc).
- Have a solid understanding of interpersonal violence and its effect on individuals and families, and working knowledge of the role that barriers play in reaching out for support and connecting with community resources and the justice system.
- Comfort in talking to and assisting individuals in crisis/in need of support around issues including but not limited to physical, emotional, psychological, sexual, and financial abuse.
- Demonstrate cultural sensitivity and the ability to work with diverse groups. Possess empathetic listening and communications and skills that can be adapted for survivors with various needs.
